A mass shooting occurred in Buffalo, New York at a Tops Friendly Markets supermarket in the East Side neighborhood. Ten people were murdered and three were injured.

The shooter was identified as 18year-old Payton S. Gendron. He was taken into custody and charged with first-degree murder.

At around 2:30 p.m., Gendron arrived at the Tops supermarket on Jefferson Avenue. He was armed with an AR-15 rifle.



Gendron shot four people in the parking lot, killing three. He then entered the store, shooting eight more people and killing six. According to a law enforcement source, he yelled racial slurs during the incident.

By 2:36 p.m., Gendron had gone to the front of the building, where patrol officers were able to talk him into dropping his gun after he reportedly aimed it at his neck.
