A 19-year-old FedEx worker, Geddy Kramer, shot and wounded six people at a FedEx facility in Kennesaw, Georgia. Just before 6 a.m. Kramer entered the facility and began shooting, according to police.

The Cobb County Police Department released the shooter's thoughts in handwritten notes.

Geddy Kramer said he suffered from mental instability, frustration, and depression. Kramer expressed no sadness and no regrets about a planned massacre. "I'm not sad or sorry for the misery I've caused," he wrote.

A co-worker who asked not to be identified because he was Kramer's best friend said that Kramer's problems at work may have caused this incident. "Just how they treated him at work - the management always complaining for him to do even more than what he was expected and him not getting paid enough," he said.
