On July 22, 1991, Jeffrey Dahmer got arrested by the police because he brutally tortured and killed 17 men and boys. Most of his victims were African American, Latino, and Asian. The way he would target his victims was by going to the bar and leading them to his house. Dahmer's routine with his victim was "sex, putting drug in the drink, death, and dismemberment".

In the early 1980's, Dahmer served in the army at Baumholder, Germany. After leaving the army and moving to Milwaukee, he began having fantasies of killing people. Dahmer committed his first murder in 1978, just after his parents divorced. When Dahmer was living with his grandma, his stepmother, Shari, said "she smelled a harsh chemical odor coming from the ground of the basement.". Dahmer's father, Lionel, investigated and found "bones and the residue in the containers, but he couldn't tell if they were human or animal bones.".

On May 14, 1990, Dahmer moved out of his grandmother's house and into a new apartment where he started killing his remaining victims. His neighbor called the police for months because there was something going on in his apartment and they didn't do anything. Dahmer was never charged for the murder of 24-year-old, Steven.
