On November 30th, 2021, in Oakland County, Michigan, Ethan Crumbley committed a mass shooting at Oxford High School that killed four students. Hours before the shooting, the school counselor suspected that Ethan showed suicidal ideations.

After the incident, police discovered Ethan's planner, which stated "The shooting is tomorrow. I have access to the gun and the ammo.". Also, "The first victim has to be a pretty girl with a future so she can suffer like me.". This was written on November 29th, the day before the shooting.

Upon talking with Ethan's parents, Ethan's dad, James Crumbley, admitted that he bought him a gun 4 days prior to the shooting. Later on, the police found a gun safe in the master bedroom which contained 2 unloaded guns. The parents said that they had given Ethan the pass code to the safe.
