On June 1, 2022, a mass shooting occurred in St. Francis Hospital, Tulsa, Oklahoma. The shooter, Michael Louis, entered a physicians' office building at Tulsa's Saint Francis Hospital campus late in the afternoon and shot dead his surgeon, Dr. Preston Phillips, and three other people before fatally shooting himself.

Tulsa Police Chief Wendell Franklin stated that shortly before the attack, Michael Louis, bought an AR-15-style semi-automatic rifle from a gun store at 2 p.m. and also had bought a .40-caliber pistol from a pawn shop.

Louis, of Muskogee, a city roughly 45 miles southeast of Tulsa, had back surgery on May 19 performed by Phillips, and was released from a hospital on May 24. He then called Phillips' office several times over several days, complaining of pain and wanting additional treatment. The day before the shooting, Louis saw Phillips for treatment, and called Phillips' office again moments before the shooting, "complaining of back pain and wanting additional assistance."
