AAR: Police Delayed Assault on School Shooting Suspect

On May 24th, 2022, a mass shooting occurred at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas. Salvador Ramos, a former student at the school, killed 19 children and two teachers.

Ramos bought gun accessories and purchased 60 rounds of ammunition. The teen had hinted on social media that an attack was coming. "He said the kids should watch out.".

On the morning of the attack, Ramos sent a direct message to an individual on a Facebook platform stating "I'm going to shoot an elementary school.". After Ramos shot his grandmother, he fled with his pickup truck, crashing it outside Robb Elementary School. Salvador Ramos was in the school for more than an hour before being killed by the police.

Ramos had a history of violence and "loved" abusing animals, and loved picking on people. He also allegedly threatened women with sexual violence. Before turning 18, Ramos had asked 2 people to buy guns for him, including his sister, but they refused to do so. Salvador's interest in the gun should have sparked awareness to the individuals that he had asked.
