A mass shooting occurred at the Greenwood Park Mall in Greenwood, Indiana. Three people were killed and two others were injured in the shooting.

Around 4:55 p.m. the perpetrator, 20-year-old Jonathan Sapirman, walked a mile from his apartment to the mall, carrying a semi-automatic rifle, a pistol, and over 100 rounds of ammunition.

He went into a restroom near the mall's food court and did not come out until an hour and two minutes later, at which point he started shooting.

At 5:56 p.m., he first shot and killed Indianapolis native Victor Gomez, who was standing near the restroom entrance.

He then turned and fired at a nearby table, fatally shooting Pedro and Rosa Pineda, a married couple from Indianapolis. Sapirman then continued to fire at mall patrons, injuring a 22-year-old woman and a 12-year-old girl.

Fifteen seconds after the shooting began, Elisjsha Dicken, a legally armed 22-year-old man from Seymour, engaged the shooter in a gunfight, hitting the shooter eight times.
